The Iranian Endowment and Charity Organization, with the blessings of Allah, is proud to hold the 39th international Holy Quran Competition of Iran and the 5th Islamic Seminary Student-only Holy Quran Competition in 2022 in order to unite the Islamic nation to serve the Holy Quran, and also to share the experiences of Quranic elites and recognized figures of the Islamic World.

Entry requirement:

- 1) Being technically qualified in the chosen field;
- 2) Holding citizenship of the country representing (holding the passport of the intended country);
- 3) Not having attended any Iranian Competitions in the past two years;
- 4) Not having any top finishes in any competition for the last five years
- 5) Being in the qualified age group (see the table of fields);
- 6) Being a permanent resident of the respective country.

Remarks:

- 1) Every participant can only choose one field.
- 2) The chosen field cannot be changed after submitting the completed registration form.
- 3) The organizer only covers the costs and fees for the VISA, return ticket, and accommodation during the competition in Iran. Other expenses, including personal expenses, domestic travels, and changing the flight date and itinerary upon the guest's request shall be covered by the participant, and the organizer shall not be responsible for them.
- 4) The required documents include a 3-minute video file of recitation, a copy of the 1st page of passport (with at least 1-year validity), and a high-resolution scanned photo taken recently should be attached to the application form and sent to the Political and Cultural Representative Offices of IR Iran.
- 5) The deadline for registration is september. 22, 2022.
- 6) The applicants applying for the men-only section of "Islamic Seminary Alumni and Students" should also send documents demonstrating they are studying or graduates in the religious sciences in addition to the above documents.

Competition Fields:

(1) Tahqeeq (All sections)

The participants shall choose one of the parts below and send their recitation with the full observance of the Tajweed, Waqf, Ibtida, Lahn, etc. according to the by-law of the I.R. Iran competition jury in a 4-minute video file (maximum size: 20 M) through the designated contact information of the organizer.

(2) Quran Memorization (All Sections)

The preliminary examination of Holy Quran memorization shall be held live online with the prior appointment set for each participant, for which the organizer will make a video call. In this exam, the participant should answer three (12 to 15 line) questions raised by the jury members (one question from the first ten Parts (Juz'), one from the second ten Parts (Juz'), and one from the third ten parts (Juz) in Tarteel format.

(3) Tarteel

The participants shall choose one of the parts below and send their recitation with the full observance of the Tajweed, Waqf, Ibtida, Lahn, etc. according to the by-law of the I.R. Iran competition jury in a 3-minute video file (maximum size: 20 Mb) through the designated contact information of the organizer.

This competition will be held in two parts:

Part 1: Virtual and through sending the video file of Khataba delivered.

The participant must choose from one of the five topics below, deliver a 5-7 minute Khitaba (in fluent Arabic), and record his performance. Then he should send the file (Max. 20 Mb) through the I.R. Iran Political and Cultural Representative or email it to the secretariat of the competition.

Topics:

- 1) The goals of the Mab'aath of the Holy Prophet (PBUH) from an ethical and training viewpoint;
- 2) The features of the Holy Prophet's lifestyle in the Holy Quran;
- 3) The Holy Prophet's conduct towards Muslims, Atheists, and hypocrites;
- 4) Techniques of the Holy Prophet (PBUH) to attract and guide humans;
- 5) Our duties towards the Holy Prophet (PBUH);

(5) Exegesis of the Holy Quran (Only for Islamic Seminary Students)

- * The medium (language) of the exegesis exam is Arabic
- * The exam sources for Al-Ahqaf, Muhammad, Al-Fath, Al-Hujurat, and Qaf include books entitled "الامثل في تفسير كتاب الله المنزل" by Naser Makarem Shirazi, Al-Tanveer and Al-Tahreer by Muhammad Al-Taher Ibn Ashoor.
- * The participant can choose either of the books when registering for the competition
- * The exam will be held in two phases, namely the preliminaries and the finals
- * The preliminary phase will be virtual, which includes an online written exam and a live interview. Having earned 50% of the total points in the written exam, the participant can attend the live interview. The interview will also be held virtual, and the secretariat of the competition will set the date and time for each interviewee.
- * The written exam items will be from the exegesis of chapters Al-Ahqaf and Muhammad
- * The interview will include questions from chapters Al-Fath and Al-Hujurat. Each interviewee will answer two questions with no more than 5 minutes to answer each question.
- * The recognized contestants who earn the designated score in the live interview will be invited to I.R. Iran to attend the final phase.
- * The final exam will be in written and interview format and will be held in-person in Iran
- * In the final phase, the questions from the exegesis sources will be addressed to the participants in written and in-person formats
- * The exam in the final phases will include the exegesis of chapters Al-Ahqaf, Muhammad, Al-Fath, Al-Hujurat, and Qaf
